

# 1-String Horizontal Arpeggios Exercise

Play all notes on the 1st string with metronome. Then find the same arpeggios on the 2nd string (though they may be in different octaves). Do all 6 strings. Say the note names out loud while playing them.

Measure 11: DΔ (D4, F4, A4)  
Measure 12: GΔ (G4, B4, D5)  
Measures 13-16: Repeat of Measure 12.
